We need to make sure that we do not hang onto worldly things and activities that we formerly treasured. Not grudgingly letting go, but considering them rubbish in contrast to what is being gained.

But whatever things were gain to me, those things I have counted as loss for the sake of Christ. More than that, I count all things to be loss in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and count them but rubbish so that I may gain Christ.

A LESSON TO BE LEARNED AND APPLIED

Today we hear it all the time. It's nothing new. It has been and is being done in many different situations. Politics and religion seem to be the most prominent today. Name calling reveals more about the one who is doing the name calling. It reveals dislike, contempt, and hatred. It sometimes reveals the exasperation of being unable to answer or rebut something said or done (Don't like the message? Vilify the messenger.)
