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SCIENCE: FACT AND THEORY

In attempting to understand what is written or spoken, it is good to have a working knowledge of the meaning of words. This is especially true when it comes to the discussion of how human beings came into existence.

A local newspaper ran a monthly series, "How Man Began." The author, Scott Lafee, assembled a neatly segmented history of the origin of man. It is put forth as science. Here it must be noted that science, accurately defined, may involve the theoretical explanation of phenomena. It's only after theories have been tested and validated do they become fact.

The series of articles on "How Man Began," is science (theoretical explanations), but not fact. How can you tell? By the terminology found throughout the article. Following are some excerpts from part 4, "Life and Limb."

[BOLD PRINT IDENTIFIES TERMS WHICH INDICATE THEORETICAL EXPLANATIONS.]

'Stories by Scott Lafee'

"Mudskippers offer living clues to how some ancient species **may have transitioned** from fish to amphibian to terrestrial vertebrate."

"At least nine varieties of amphibious tetrapod have been found in the fossil record, each of which **appears** to have evolved independently ..."

"In 1916, American geologist, Joseph Barrell, **persuasively argued** ..." "Barrell **theorized** ..."

"Alfred Sherwood Romer pushed Barrell's **argument** further, **theorizing** . . . " "Romer did not **think** sarcopterygians estivated. . . Instead, he **argued**. . . they **may have** dragged themselves over land to other pools."

"Romer's scenario was **compelling and logical** ... Today it is still **accepted** in principle ...but new discoveries have **amended** it substantially."

"In other words, the environmental conditions leading to land vertebrates were **probably** less severe than Romer could have **imagined** ..."

"The $\ensuremath{\text{prevailing}}$ view [of why animals moved onto land] is simple: The land was there \ldots "

"What was the first tetrapod? **Based on** the admittedly **sparse fossil record**, an **argument** can be made for a creature called lchthyostega ...The tail, paleontologists **believe** was [its] primary source of propulsion in water ... it **undoubtedly** moved slowly and clumsily over land ..."

"At first tetrapod adventures ashore were **undoubtedly** brief: to rest, to capture prey or avoid becoming one, to mate or lay eggs. 'I rather **see them** like alligators...'"

The article concludes: "From these ancestral amphibians **eventually** came reptiles. And Birds. And another kind of creature closer to our hearts and selves—the first mammals."

IT'S A MATTER OF FAITH - BUT IN WHAT?

This article is an excellent example of a "theoretical explanation," but it is far from being fact. Belief (faith) in a theory does not equate to it being fact.

It takes a leap of faith to believe such theories. Yes, anyone who holds to the theory of evolution does so by faith—faith in the theoretical explanations of others.

One wonders why people labor long and hard to prove God didn't create the world. Obviously, attempts to disprove what is clearly seen in the things around us requires great effort and faith.

"... that which is known about God is evident within them; for God made it evident to them. For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, His eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made ..." Romans 1:19-20
